ONLINE CROSS-BORDER ACCOUNT LINKING AGREEMENT

Description of Service

Online Cross-Border Account Linking (the "Service") is an optional feature of Online Banking which allows you to "link" your U.S. accounts with RBC Bank (Georgia), N.A. ("we", "us" or "our") and your Canadian accounts with our affiliate, RBC Royal Bank. To access and use the Service, you must first be enrolled in our Online Banking service, and then you must separately enroll in the Service and agree to the terms and conditions of this Online Cross-Border Account Linking Agreement, as it may be amended from time to time ("this Agreement").

The Service permits you to view account information relating to your Canadian accounts by logging in to our Online Banking service, and it also permits you to make transfers of funds between your U.S. and Canadian deposit accounts using the Online Transfers feature (see "Cross-Border Online Transfers" below). You agree that all of your accounts that we deem eligible for Online Banking, and all of your accounts that RBC Royal Bank deems eligible for its similar online service, will be linked within the Service, and that you may not choose only certain specified accounts to link.

Your Representations and Warranties

With respect to consumer (personal) accounts, in this Agreement "you" and "your" refer to the individual enrolling in Online Cross-Border Account Linking and also to all joint account owners, if any such accounts are to be linked within the Service. By enrolling in Online Cross-Border Account Linking, you represent and warrant to us that you are a legal owner of each linked account and, if applicable, that you have the authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of all joint owners of linked accounts and to bind them to the terms and conditions thereof, and that such authority remains in full force and effect each time you access the Service.

With respect to non-consumer accounts (e.g., business, estate or trust accounts), "you" and "your" refer both to the entity in whose name the accounts are titled (i.e., the business, estate, trust, etc.) and also to any individual, whether one or more, who is a duly authorized representative or fiduciary for the entity and who is enrolling for the Service on its behalf. By enrolling in Online Cross-Border Account Linking, you, as the individual and as the authorized representative or fiduciary on behalf of the entity, represent and warrant to us as follows: (i) that you, the individual, are a duly authorized representative or fiduciary for the entity in whose name each linked account is titled; (ii) that you, the individual, have the requisite authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the entity and to bind it to the terms and conditions thereof; (iii) that the entity has provided to us such documentation satisfactory to evidence such authority as we may require; and (iv) that in the event the individual's authority is revoked or transferred to another person at any point in the future, the entity will promptly notify us (including notice of the name of, and such other information as we may require concerning, any newly authorized representative or fiduciary for the entity), and that you, the individual who was previously authorized, will make no further attempts to access Online Cross-Border Account Linking after your authority has been revoked or transferred.
